- ADA sleeping tents available on request

While we try to make all routes and sites as accessible as possible, some areas of the route and campsite may not be fully accessible to persons with mobility disabilities. In these instances, we will work directly with participants to make arrangements to facilitate participation. This may include offering a complimentary companion registration to support participation, providing additional sweep vehicle access, providing alternate means of transport across a campsite or other considerations as feasible.

It is the responsibility of each person participating in the Komen 3-Day to inform us of his/her specific needs on the event. We are dedicated to providing all participants with the tools and accommodations necessary for success.

In some cases, participants may choose to bring a friend/family member or attendant with them on the event to assist them on the route and in camp.
