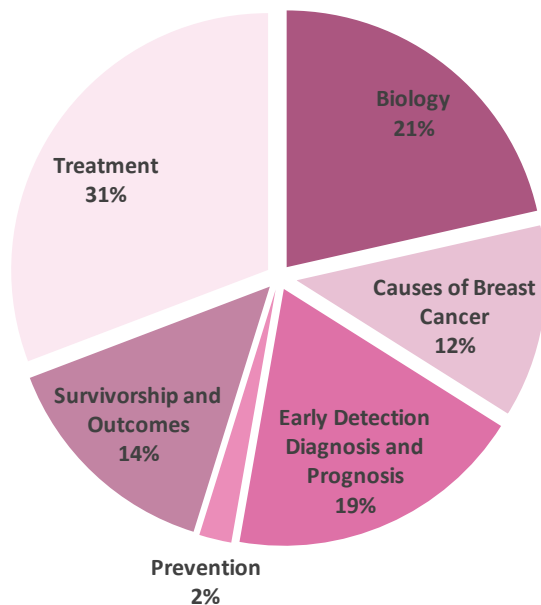

Invested more than **\$1 billion** in research

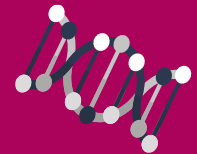
Funded nearly **2700** research grants
